Big Idea: You are not a victim. You are a victor.

HOW DO YOU STAND STRONG AND NOT GIVE UP?

1. You need to have the right attitude.

My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.
James 1:2–4 (NKJV)

- The early church called “patience” the queen of all virtues.
- Endurance is the real meaning.

Question: What is the biggest difficulty or pressure you are facing in your life right now? Have you determined to stay put, never giving up until the devil gives up his attack to defeat you?

2. You must realize you have the victory.

Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.
Colossians 2:15 (NKJV)

- You are not a victim.
- Openly: Jesus has boldly, confidently, and loudly exposed a defeated Satan.
- Triumph: was used to describe the emperor's grand victory parade when he returned home.
- You as believers possess the authority necessary to keep Satan under your feet—where he belongs.



Question: Do you approach life like you are a struggling victim or a victorious champion? What changes could you make in your thoughts, words, and attitudes to help you have a victorious approach to life?

Let us not grow weary or become discouraged in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap, if we do not give in.

Galatians 6:9 (AMP)

As a believer, you have a God-given authority to resist Satan. So stand firm, and refuse to accept defeat. You can be UNDETERRED!
